Dodge County Horse Project Members,

This is an explanation of the new Dodge County Horse form and how to sign up on line for classes for the Dodge County Horse Fair Show, including the fun show Classes N-Q.

In the past, youth were required to pick 2 premium classes and then at the show, they could sign up for additional non-premium classes. Classes were run by doing the premium classes first and then all the non-premiums for that class. It was hard for the judge, gate keeper and announcer as to who was showing in the premium/non-premium classes, in addition, the parents/youth were also confused.

It is the intention to have the youth members sign up for **ALL** the classes they will participate in at the County Fair Show.

You will enter all classes into the Blue Ribbon Online registration. Your premium will be determined by your highest placed Regular and Danish judged class. Therefore, we are asking that all youth members fill and turn in the paper registration form this year by June 16, 2020 or earlier to their General Leader or FFA Advisor. If you are showing 2 horses, 2 Dodge County Horse Forms need to be turned in.

You can drop/scratch classes the day of the show, but <u>NO entries</u> can be added the day of the show.

If you sign up for Walk/Trot/Canter (WTC) classes and if you think you may need to change to Walk/Trot (WT) the day of the show, sign up on line for both classes and let us know the day of the show which one you will enter. Horse needs to show either WTC or WT for the entire show.

This change will also help the volunteers. The classes all youth are in will be ready to go and make the show run smoothly. The announcer will be able to announce who is in the class by name so that you can be ready at the gate. The gate keeper will be able to check you in as well and let the judge know of any changes.

Grand and Reserve will be announced after everyone has completed the class. In addition, the announcer will be able to give recognition by name of the youth placings in the class. You will receive your premium based on the highest placing received in your Regular and Danish Judged classes. You can receive up to 2 premiums per horse.

For Example: If you sign up for Showmanship, Hunt Seat Equitation, Stock Seat Equitation (Danish classes) and Halter, Hunter Pleasure and Western Pleasure, and Trail (regular classes). If you place in all your classes, the highest placing in the Danish and Regular Judged class will be your premium class.

A question that may come up would there be concern over a youth not receiving a premium. You will receive a premium in the Danish judge class no matter how many are entered; everyone receives a placing.

The goal of the Dodge County 4-H Horse and Pony project is to provide a fun, family friendly, learning experience for all ages. We want new families to learn, and grow, as they are the future of this sport.
