

2024 Camping Guidelines

General Guidelines:

- Camping permits will be available for purchase starting July 18th at the Dodge County Fair Office at 9am.
- Permits are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Permits may be purchased from 9:00am 2:00pm weekdays, July 18th until the Fair
- Camping permits are \$100 (checks made payable to *Dodge County Fair*)
- Permits are valid for the week of the Dodge County Fair: August 12 August 18
- Campsite size is 20 feet by 40 feet
- **Same as last year: Camping spaces are numbered. You will be able to select a specific space at your time of payment; only one camping site is available per person; NO SPOT SAVING
- No early parking NO EXCEPTIONS
- Purchasing permits prior to August 12 is *highly* encouraged to expedite move-in process. **Display this in a window of your camper so that it is clearly visible.**
- **CONTINUED for 2024** One vehicle per campsite. Vehicle must have hangtag displayed in window of vehicle

Move-in Procedure:

- Move in time: Monday, August 12 @ 7:00am or later; *Campers placed before this time will be removed*. Move in times are 7:00am noon and 4:00pm 6:00pm.
- All campers use the Fabisch Road entrance
- A Fair Camper Attendant will be waiting to check you in when you arrive
- You must pay before you park your camper
- All campers MUST be backed in NO EXCEPTIONS
- Fire lane must not be parked in as it needs to be open for emergencies

Camping Reminders:

- Be courteous of your neighbors
- No open fires
- No excessive loud music or noise
- No dogs allowed in camping area
- Each camper occupant must hold or purchase fair admission for each day in attendance; Fair admission is NOT included with the camper permit
- Absolutely no dumping of gray or black water or you will be asked to leave without refund

Fair officials reserve the right to refuse and/or revoke this permit at any time.
